"Nothing else exists beyond what can be seen and scientifically tested (including 'mind' or any other force or reality)."






The Bible tells a universal story of interest and ultimate benefit for all people of every generation and ethnicity.

## 10 of the most valuable Bible stories — Enjoy!

Prologue: 1st distinct Starting Point: "God started everything" (Genesis 1:1)

- 1. God created everything: 2<sup>nd</sup> distinct Starting Point (Genesis 1-2); "He gave the earth (universe) to humans" (Psalms 115)
- 2. The Story of God 3rd distinct Starting Point (Acts 17:24-31)
- 3. Garden: (Genesis 2:8-17 & chpt. 3)
  - a. We blew it "Only God is good" (Matt. 19:17)
  - b. Restart needed
- 4. Abraham: (Genesis 11-25) "God: I certify my Covenant forever"
  - a. Covenant: God's unbreakable commitment to love us
  - b. Faith: reliance on God; trust him
- 5. Job: teaches us the limits of what we can learn about God from nature and from human experience (Book of Job)
- 6. Exodus & Covenant: 10 Words = Covenant Stipulations (Exodus 1-20)
  - a. Rescue from slavery
  - b. Covenant stipulated
- 7. **Jesus** Son of God, co-Creator, Mediator of God's Covenant, final Prophet & King of everything (Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke & John)
  - a. Incarnation
  - b. Mediator
- 8. Crucifixion & Resurrection: "Heir of the whole creation" (Colossians 1:15; Matthew 26-28; Mark 14-16; Luke 22-24; John 18-21)
- 9. God's Spirit & the Church: living today (Book of the Acts)
- 10. Final (The Book of the Revelation)
  - a. Accountability & Judgment
  - b. After => New Everything
